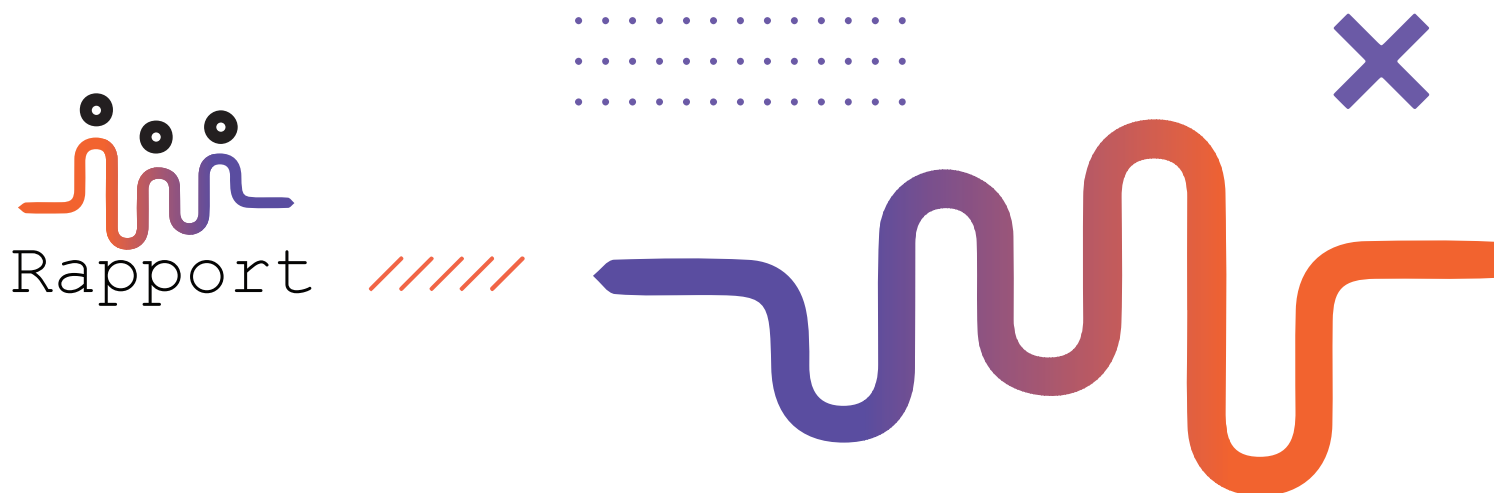




RAPPORr Project: Third Project Team Meeting Held in Larisa, Greece

As part of the international RAPPORr project, the third meeting of the partner team was successfully held in the city of Larisa, Greece. During the meeting, the partners reviewed the project activities implemented so far, defined the next steps of implementation, and finalized key content intended for the development of modern competencies in vocational education and training.

A special focus of the meeting was placed on the development of tools, teaching materials, and content for the platform modules covering Digital Skills, Green Skills, and Entrepreneurial Skills. Within the project, educational materials were developed for all three competency components – DigiComp, EntreComp, and GreenComp – aimed at strengthening applied knowledge and skills aligned with European competency frameworks. The training programmes directly address labour market needs identified in the RAPPORr Project Consolidated Report, with the goal of improving the quality of vocational education and strengthening relevant competencies for the future of work.

All developed materials were successfully harmonized and adapted into the languages of all partner organizations, ensuring accessibility and high-quality content for users from different countries involved in the project. The partners are currently working on finalizing the online platform, which will include educational courses, interactive content, and all necessary materials for acquiring new knowledge and skills. The platform has been developed through the joint efforts of all project partners and will be available in the languages of the partner organizations.

The aim of the developed programmes and platform is to improve vocational education through the strengthening of digital, green, and entrepreneurial competencies, as well as the modernization of educational approaches in line with the demands of the modern labour market. The programme additionally enhances the ability of learners and participants to use tools and modern skills safely, efficiently, and responsibly in the workplace, supporting their employability, adaptability, and continuous professional development at Level 5 of the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).

The courses developed through the RAPPORr project will contribute to strengthening the capacities of vocational education and training institutions, increasing the competitiveness of participants, and improving the connection between the education system and the needs of the economy and labour market.

The RAPPORr project once again confirms the importance of international cooperation in developing innovative educational solutions that respond to the challenges of digital transformation, the green transition, and the modern labour market. Through its ongoing activities, the project continues to develop high-quality and accessible educational content aimed at strengthening the competencies needed for the future of work and lifelong learning.



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
